



Memorandum of Agreement On Academic Activities Program Between Faculty of Social and Political Sciences University of Mulawarman Indonesia and Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences Khon Kaen University Thailand

Under the terms of "Memorandum of Agreement (MoA)" between Faculty of Social and Political Sciences, University of Mulawarman Indonesia (hereinafter referred to as UNMUL) and Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences Khon Kaen University Thailand (hereinafter referred to as KKU) hereby agree to establish an agreement to the Academic Activities Program (hereinafter referred to as AAP) under the Agreement on Academic Activities Program concluded on November 2020, with the purpose of mutual understanding between both universities and contributing to the academic and educational development as well as to facilitate the supervision for lecturer, academic staff and student between both universities. Both universities agree to implement the APP as stipulated in term below:

- The program is to be brought into effect the AAP of lecturer, academic satff and student in all degree; Bachelor, Master and Doctoral degree of Faculty of Social and Political Sciences, University of Mulawarman, Indonesia (hereinafter referred to as UNMUL) and Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences Khon Kaen University, Thailand (hereinafter referred to as KKU)- Both Universities
- 2. The program's purpose is to assist lecturer, academic staff and student of both universities to conduct various academic activities as stated below:
 - a. Cooperative effort with professor exchange or internship programs;

This program can be carried out referring to the representatives of each study program collaborated. The sending and exchange of lecturers will be financed by each sending University. Requirements to participate in this program are permanent lecturers who have position a minimum level of assistant professor and able to communicate in English orally and in writing as evidenced by a minimum score of paper based TOEFL of 500 or IELTS 5.00.

b. Joint participation in sponsoring or co-hosting of international conferences and education festivals;

International conferences or education festivals is conducted annually collaborated with at least five of ASEAN countries and ten Universities. The host for the conferences or education festivals is in the alternate place of both universities. The seminar theme refers to the actual issues which are challenging and interesting for the research study in both Universities.

c. Mutually identified international teaching training projects;

The program will be focused to teaching innovation for students at all levels (bachelor or master degree). The innovation is conducted by improving the research methodology especially in social and politics sciences including the updated data analysis for current research. Programs will involve students that have taken the research methodology for social sciences course.

c. Joint participation in research and journal publication.

The programs include (1) exchange of scientific research materials, publication, information and service, (2) development of mutually agreed upon collaborative research projects, (3) joint proposals for international funding for research projects, and (4) the exchange of research personnel.

d. Mutual participation in student exchange programs;

Each student involved in an exchange program will be subject to the admission requirements from each host university including tuition fee, English proficiency, and total number of credit course that has been taken. For bachelor study, students have to have a minimum score of paper based TOEFL of 450. Or, a total score of paper base IELTS around 4.5. In addition students have to take more than half number of total credit number for prerequisite of their bachelor study.

For the implementation of Student Exchange Program, there are several requirements that must be considered by the two institutions. First, undergraduate student requirements: At least half of the credits that must be taken have been completed, score of paper based TOEFL at least 450. Second, master study, students have to finish their courses in respective study program, and the exchange program is focused on the thesis completion. The tuition fee, living and transportation expenses will be subject to the sending university, whereas the accommodation cost is subject to both universities sharing.

- 3. The Most shall become effective upon signature by the representative of both universities for e priod of three years. Any amandement and modification, as well as extension or termination of this Agreement may be made by the mutual agreement of both universities.
- 4. All Intellectual Property generated in this program and/or activities covered by this MoA are deemed to be joint property of both universities in accordance to the contribution agreement.
